ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, the pay and allowances of State Government Employees and Teachers were revised. Subsequently the pay and allowances of Dental Surgeons of Health Services Department were modified as per the G.O. read as 2nd paper above. The Labour Department has proposed to extend the merger of 76% of Common Special Allowance to the basic pay of Dental Surgeons of Insurance Medical Services Department also, as in the case of Dental Surgeons of Health Services Department granted vide Government Order read as 2nd paper above.

2)Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to issue the following orders in partial modification to the Government Order read as 1st paper above.

i) All doctors in the Dental Category in Insurance Medical Services Department shall be allowed to revise the pay as per general conditions laid down in Government Order read as 1st paper above. After revising the pay, 76% of existing Common Special Allowance shall be merged with the revised basic pay as on 01.07.2009 or any subsequent date to which the incumbent comes over to the revised pay and fix the pay on the next higher stage in the scale of pay. The entry level basic pay of Dental Doctors will be as follows.

- ii) This revision shall take effect from 01.07.2009 as notional and have monetary benefit with effect from 01.08.2011 only provided, this revision will no longer affect the monetary benefit accrued consequent to the 9th Pay Revision Order.
- iii) The Common Special Allowance so merged would be part of the basic pay for all existing incumbents and will be protected in the next pay revision.

- iv) The Common Special Allowance will cease to exist after merging 76% of it to the revised basic pay and remaining Common Special Allowance will not be admissible.
- v) The two advance increments granted to the post of Assistant Dental Surgeons vide General Pay Revision Order 2009 will be reviewed and withdrawn as two level higher start of pay is not feasible. The merging of Common Special Allowance will be effected in the basic pay without reckoning the two advance increments.
3. All doctors in the Dental Category in Insurance Medical Services Department coming under the purview of this order will be allowed to exercise revised option to the 9th Pay Revision within 3 months from the date of this order.
4. The entry level basic pay of Junior Dental Consultant/Dental Assistant Surgeon specified in the Government Order read as 2nd paper above will be corrected and read as ₹ 23480/-


